1.0 Purpose of Report

1.1 To set the charges for the beach hut licenses for 2019/20.

2.0 Decision

2.1 To agree no change to the current charges for beach hut licenses for 2019/20.

3.0 Issue

- 3.1 The council's policy is to keep beach hut fees in line with market forces. As the council's beach hut fees are already at the top end in comparison to other local authorities, a freeze in costs would ensure the service is affordable to existing customers, thereby protecting existing income and attracting new customers should sites become available
- 3.2 It is necessary to agree to the beach hut license charges in advance of the budget due to the:
 - requirement for invoices to be sent out in good time for the start of next season, giving customers notice of the fees they will be charged for 2019/20
 - need to secure the licenses for 2019/20 prior to the start of the financial year.
