Since publishing the Committee agenda, 3 additional representations have been received in respect of the application which are summarised below:

7.54 Please note that, following review of the floorspace figures liable for the Community Infrastructure Levy in the development, the CIL liability for the development is £231,891.07.

Response to questions from Site Viewing Working Party

At the meeting on the Site Viewing Working Party on 9th March 2023 it was resolved that the following information be provided to the Planning Committee:

- (i) The adequacy of the proposed provision for parent/child and disabled parking spaces; and
- (ii) The availability of electric vehicle charging points

Officer Comment

- In accordance with the Council's Parking SPD, 5% of car parking spaces are allocated for disabled users. There is no specific requirement for a certain level of parent/child spaces to be provided, however, 8 spaces have been provided.
- No electric vehicle charging points have been provided, nor have they been requested by the Highway Authority, however, the applicant has expressed a willingness to install charging points in consultation with future occupiers.
